





- ★ Visit the magnificent Tesselaar Tulip Festival. Experience a kaleidoscope of colour with more than a million bulbs, live entertainment and delicious food. Have time to wander this working farm in the Dandenong Ranges, listen to the Dutch organ, see the world's largest Clog and purchase some lunch at the food court.
- ★ We will drive north to Broadford via Yarra Glen, Kinglake and Whittlesea.

Accommodation: Quorn, Leigh Creek, Peterborough

Highlights of the tour:

- ★ Embark on you outback adventure heading north. Our first comfort stop will be Balaklava including morning tea.
- ★ Travelling onwards we arrive at Laura for lunch, which of course will include a local Golden North Giant Twin ice cream.
- ★ Travel to Quorn, home of the Pichi Richi Railway to be treated to a ride on the iconic railway. Travel from Quorn to Woolshed Flat and return, passing by scenic landscape and stopping at Woolshed Flat whilst the train turns around. You may purchase light refreshments here, but it is cash only.
- ★ Make a stop at Kanyaka Ruins, formally a cattle & sheep station in the Flinders Ranges, established in 1852 by Hugh Proby after he emigrated to South Australia in 1851 from Lincolnshire in England.
- ★ Visit the amazing Jeff Morgan Gallery and see the incredible display's housed across several large enclosure's which include the painted panoramas, one of which is the Wilpena Panorama, 3.5 m high & 33 m in circumference and taking 4,000 hours to complete.
- ★ Stop in Marree which was home of Australia's first Mosque, which was made of mud brick and built by the cameleers employed at Marree's inception.
- ★ Travel onto Beltana Town & Homestead, a town that began in the 1870's with the advent of copper mining, the construction of the Overland Telegraph Line and The Ghan railway.
- ★ Cross into the Flinders Ranges with our first stop at Blinman, named after Robert Blinman, a local shepherd and nicknamed Peg Leg, as he only had one leg
- ★ Stop at Stokes Hill Lookout for an amazing panoramic view of Flinders Ranges & Wilpena Pound. See the 3D model of the area.
- ★ Arrive at Peterborough check into the Roundhouse Motel and have an early dinner thus enabling us to see the "Sound & Light Show" at Steamtown at night.
- ★ Visit Hallett and the restored home of Sir Hubert Wilkins and his family, who was an Australian polar explorer, ornithologist, pilot, soldier, geographer and photographer.

- ★ Stay at Beechworth, famous for it's major growth in the gold rush days in the mid 1850's. It has many well preserved historical buildings and Robert O'Hara Bourke, of the ill fated Burke and Wills expedition was stationed at Beechworth as Senior Inspector of Police in the 1850's
- ★ Visit the Ned Kelly discovery hub at Glenrowan, an insight into the 1800's and the Ned Kelly gang.
- ★ Walk the streets of Rushworth, another Victorian gold mining town.
- ★ See the stunning five painted silo's at Colbinabbin
- ★ Stop at Lake Boga, where during WW II a secret airbase was located near the town. Lake Boga was a RAAF flying boat maintenance facility during the war and a PBY Catalina flying boat is on display.
- ★ Our last night will be at Swan Hill, home of the Giant Murray Cod.
- ★ Tonight we will experience the laser light show "Heartbeat of the Murray" at The Pioneer Settlement.
- ★ We will travel back home via Sea Lake, Ouyen & Murrayville with lunch at Lameroo.
